Shirley Heinze Land Trust will be holding a volunteer workday on Saturday, July 14, 2012 from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at Bur Oak Woods in Hobart, IN. Bur Oak Woods is an 84 acre savanna remnant characterized by very large, open-grown bur oaks. Nearly a century of fire suppression has drastically impacted species composition of the savanna. Over the past four years we have worked diligently removing non fire tolerant trees and re-establishing a diverse herbaceous plant community. Please join us as we conduct our annual vegetation monitoring of the site. We will be using densitometers to take canopy density measurements as well as sampling the shrub layer diversity/coverage. Lunch will be provided. Please RSVP volunteer@heinzetrust.org if you wish to attend, so we can plan accordingly.

Directions to Site:

From Ridge Rd. (East 37th Ave) in Hobart, travel south on Liverpool Road about 1.3 miles. The woods are south of the railroad tracks. Parking lot is located on the east side of Liverpool Road, at the south end of the woods. Preserve is bordered by homes on the south and east, by a single house (on a deep, triangular shaped lot) on north and Liverpool Rd on west.
